Send us your medical reports and we will assess the validity of the whole person impairment assessed by the examining physician. We will convert the impairment to a disability level utilizing the new PDRS. In addition, we will provide an analysis of the impairment given by the physician. If there are deficiencies in the analysis and impairment given, we will point those out. We will provide you with a basis to attack the report, if possible. If the physician has not properly followed the *AMA Guides*, we will provide you with the appropriate questions to ask to get the report revised to properly address the impairment under the *AMA Guides*.
